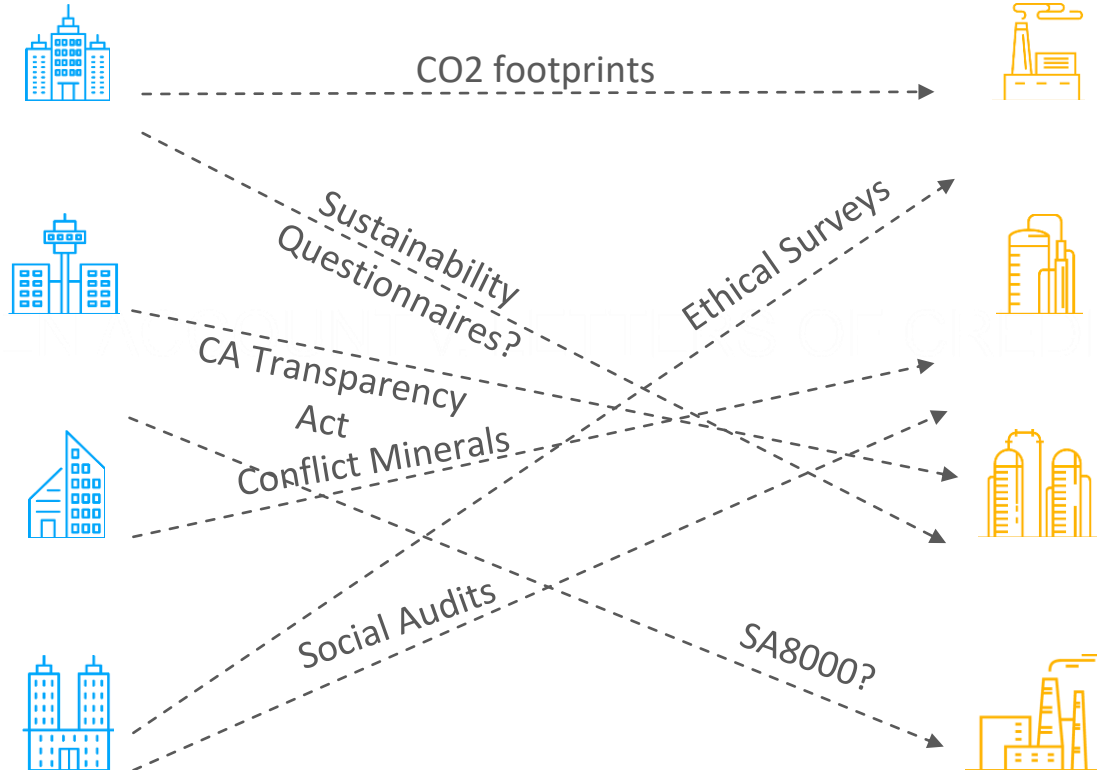

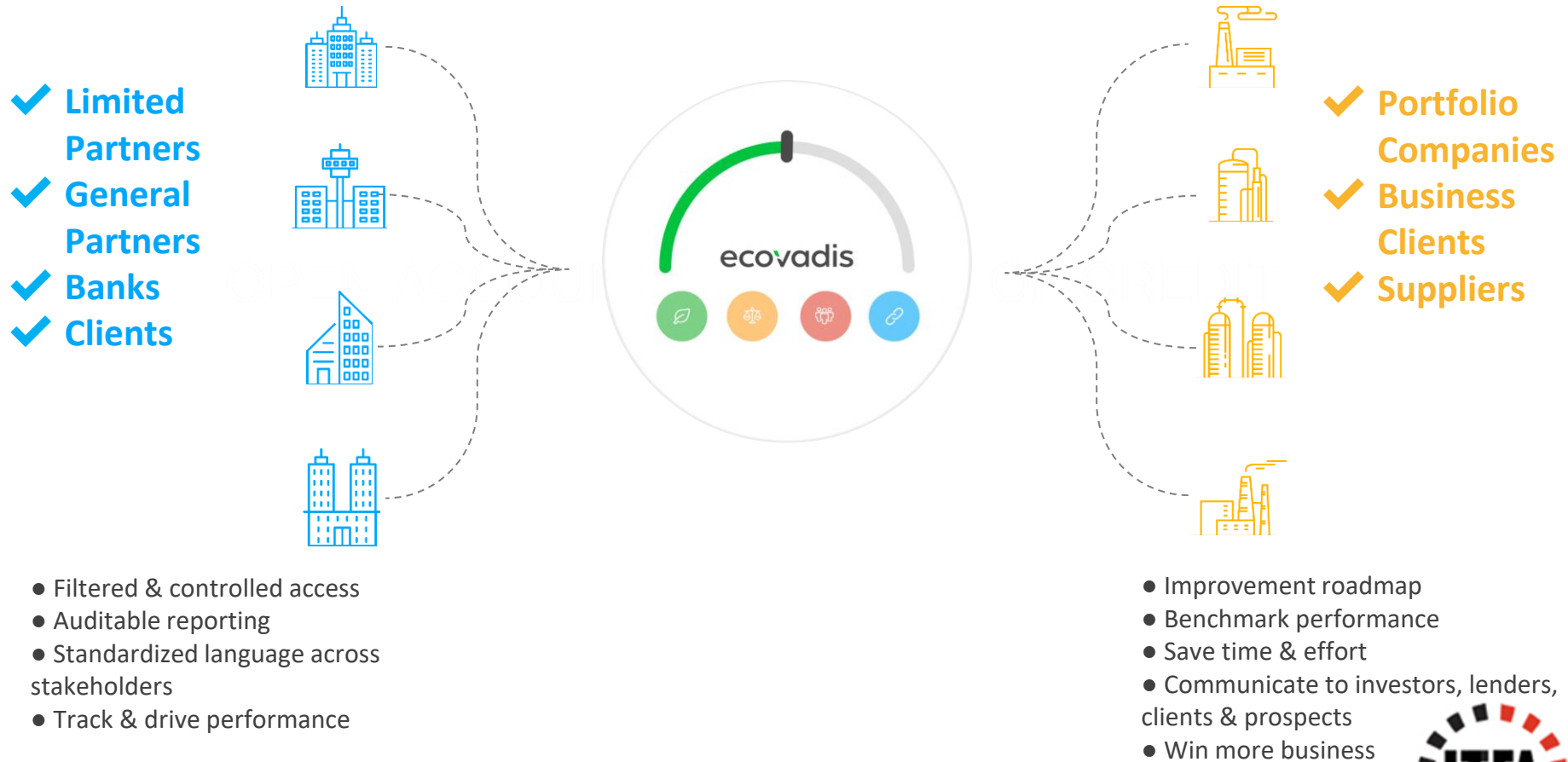

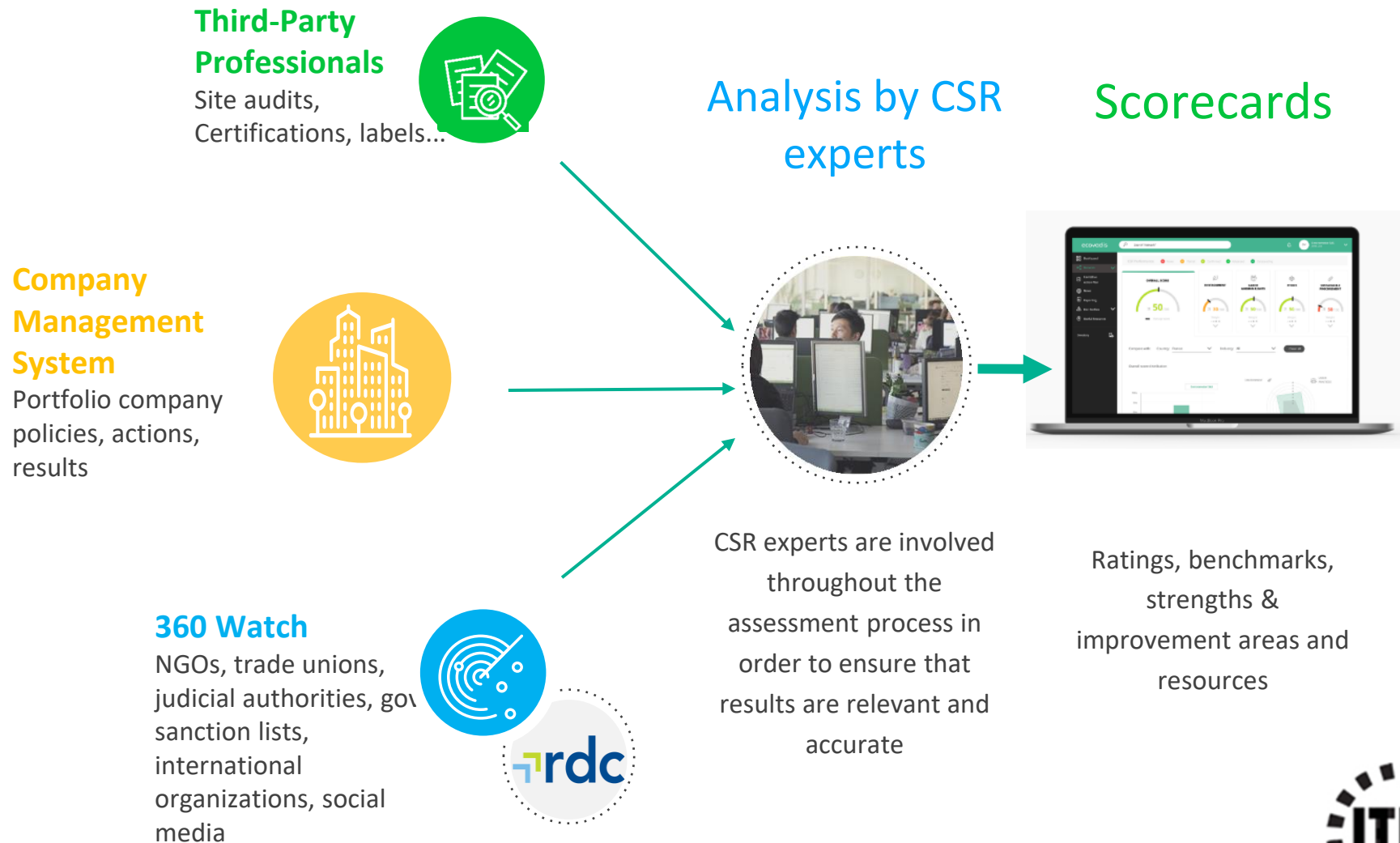

Assessment: EcoVadis Rating Model



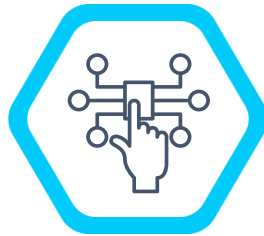

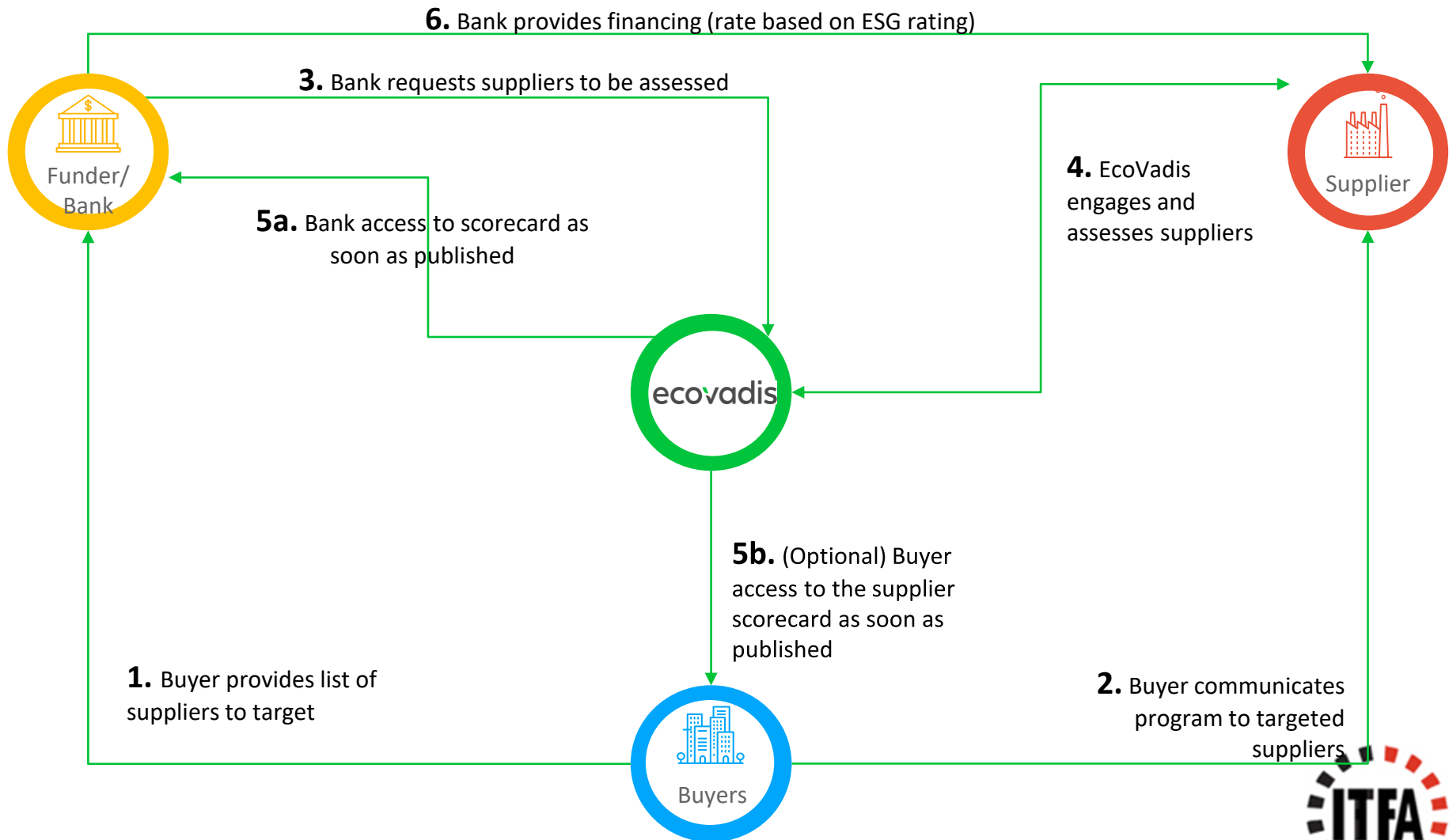
