Charles Bryant is Secretary General and founder of the European E-invoicing Service Providers Association (EESPA), which brings together 70 firms active in providing e-invoicing and supply chain automation services. He sits on the European Multi-Stakeholder Forum for e-Invoicing and the CEN Technical Committee for e-invoicing standards.

In the area of supply chain finance, he was editor on behalf of the International Chamber of Commerce and a consortium of finance-related associations for the publication: 'Standard Definitions for Techniques of Supply Chain Finance'.

Charles was formerly secretary general at the European Payments Council responsible for the Single Euro Payments Area payment schemes; senior adviser at the Euro Banking Association, which published a well-regarded guide to supply chain finance; a director and executive at SWIFT in Brussels; consulting roles with Tungsten Network and others; and had a 25 year career in a number of international banks, such as NatWest, Midland and Chase, with senior assignments in London, New York, Hong Kong, and Sydney with a specialisation in trade finance and international services.
